

## CHAMPIONSHIP RULES 2017

1. It is the responsibility of the player(s) named on the top line of a match to contact their opponents to organise a time to play.
2. Players should be ready to commence play no later than 15 minutes after the agreed time, even if there are no courts available.
3. Queuing is on a first come, first served basis, Championship matches having no automatic priority over Handicap matches. A group of people may join the queue only when all of the players for their match are present at courtside and available to play. If one player for a match is already on court, his/her partner/opponents may not join the queue.
4. Matches are the best of 3 sets: there is a Tie-break at 6 games each in every set.
5. The winner of two clear points after deuce wins the game (ie. Full games, advantage is to be played)
6. The result of a match should be written up on the Draw Sheet in the Clubhouse immediately after the match, and the result also texted to Tom McKeogh on 086 273 4699
