

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES 2020

1. It is the responsibility of the player(s) named on the top line of a match to contact their opponents to organise a time to play.
2. Courts must be booked in advance through SKEDDA.
3. Players should be ready to commence play at time of booking. If matches overrun the scheduled time, the following booking must wait until match is completed.
4. Results MUST BE TEXTED through to Tom McKeogh on 086 273 4699 immediately after match
5. Matches are the best of 3 sets: there is a tie-break at 6 games each in every set.
6. The winner of two clear points after deuce wins the game (i.e. full games, advantage is to be played)
