



## Championship RULES 2018

It is the responsibility of the player(s) named on the top line of a match to contact their opponents to organise a time to play.

Players should be ready to commence play no later than 15 minutes after the agreed time, even if there are no courts available.

Queuing is on a first come, first served basis, Championship matches having no automatic priority over Handicap matches. A group of people may join the queue only when all of the players for their match are present at courtside and available to play. If one player for a match is already on court, his/her partner/opponents may not join the queue.

Matches are the best of 3 sets: there is a Tie-break at 6 games each in every set.

The winner of two clear points after deuce wins the game (i.e. full games, advantage is to be played)

The result of a match should be written up on the Draw Sheet in the Clubhouse immediately after the match.
